

## SUPPLIES / FEES

- Each student will be supplied with his/her own copy of all music to be rehearsed and/or performed. The music should be **kept neatly in a choir folder (1/2in Black)**. Music will be checked out to the student and must be returned in good condition. Any music that is lost or returned in damaged condition must be replaced at the current market replacement cost for the music.
- Students will be issued an OTHS Choir Garment Bag. All Tompkins Choir uniforms should be transported using this bag to ensure the longevity of our uniforms. Each child is responsible for the care of their assigned bag and is solely responsible for returning it in proper condition at the end of the year. The student is financially responsible for replacing or repairing any Tompkins Choir Garment Bag that is returned in a condition that is not acceptable or if the bag has been lost or destroyed.
- Each student must pay a **\$100.00 Choir Fee**. This fee covers the following:
  - Uniform usage, and cleaning
  - Choir composite picture sitting fee
  - Choir T-shirt (1<sup>st</sup> year choir members only)
  - Garment Bag Rental Fee
  - Purchasing of music/materials
  - Accompanist and Choreographer Fees for standard concerts
- Each student must provide a **black 1/2" 3-Ring Binder with a clear plastic cover**. This folder may be stored in the folder cabinets provided in the choir room.
- Students must have a pencil with an eraser for all rehearsals.
- Students who participate in the All-State Audition Process must purchase their own music. The music packet may be purchased at AMC Music. Their website is [www.amcmusic.net](http://www.amcmusic.net) . **The contest entry fee for the District Level is \$20.**
- Students who participate in UIL Solo & Ensemble Contest are responsible for paying the entry fee which is \$12 per person per event as well as the accompanist fee of \$35.
- Choir students who choose to go on the Choir Spring Trip are responsible for paying their individual cost for the spring trip.
